Safer Homes is here to support H&F residents, who are either elderly or disabled, with small but essential tasks within their home that are needed in order to reduce the risk of an accident during this period of self isolation. Tasks include changing a light bulb, or battery in a smoke alarm, tacking down carpet or wires that are a trip hazard or even replacing a faulty lock. Regrettably we are unable to do any plumbing or electrical work. We ask recipients to cover the cost of any materials and, if they are able, make a donation to the project.

Our handyman has all the necessary protective equipment – face mask, eye covering, gloves, sanitiser and will only visit if he and all members of his household are free of any illness. We can only make visits to the homes of residents who are also symptom free and there is space to carry out the work 2 meters away from any member of the household.
