Social distancing adhered to at all times

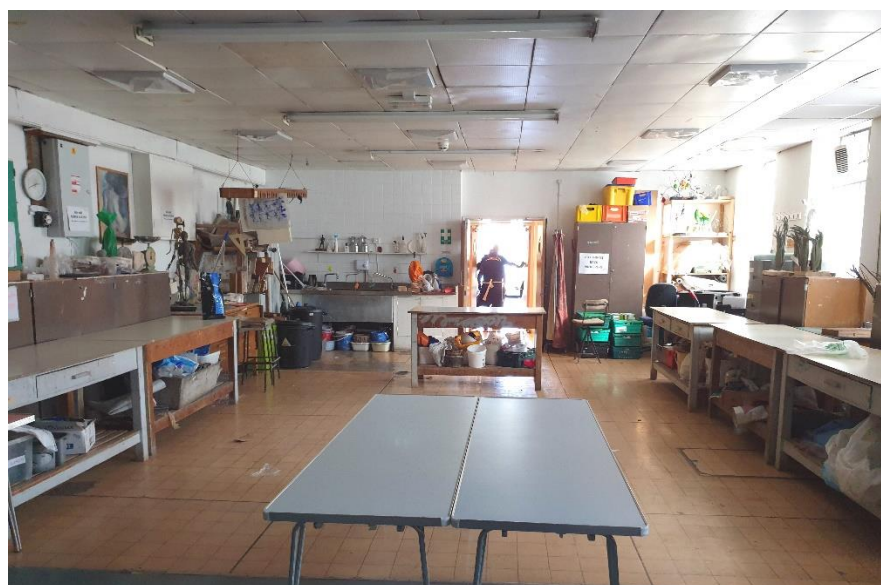
Gloves and masks to be worn at all times
