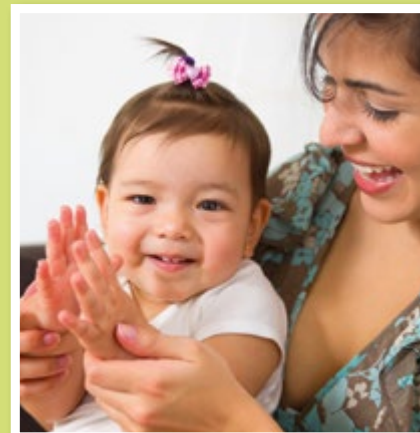

MASBRO BROOK GREEN UNDER THREES' NURSERY

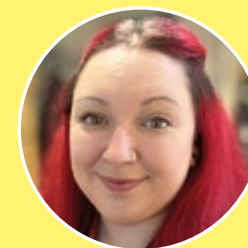


Welcome to our friendly little nursery in the heart of Brook Green. We offer eligible families fifteen hours of free childcare as part of the government's two-year offer.
